



USA CYCLING

The following packet includes information on the 2007 Encino Velodrome Championships. These Championships will qualify riders directly to the 2007 USA Cycling Elite National Track Championships to be held in Carson, CA at the ADT Event Center on October 4-7. The 2007 Elite National Track Championships are a key way for riders to qualify for the 2008 USA Cycling Talent Pool Team. Riders **MUST** be a member of the 2008 USAC Talent Pool Team to qualify for the U.S. Team that will compete at the 2008 Olympic Games. *In other words, the Velodrome Championships are one of the first steps towards making the 2008 Olympic Team.*

The 2007 USAC Velodrome Championships are open to male cyclists who hold a valid USA Cycling or UCI International racing license, have a racing age of 16 or above and are track category 4 and above for time trial events and track category 3 or above for mass start events. Female cyclists who hold a valid USA Cycling or UCI International racing license and have a racing age of 16 or above can ride in all events. This means that there may be riders competing in the Velodrome Championships who may **NOT** be qualified to ride the USA Cycling Elite National Track Championships. The inclusion of these riders is not to preclude another rider from competing but to allow for more cyclists to compete at the local level.

- Medals:** *USA Cycling* will provide medals for the top 3 cyclists.
- Qualification:** Riders qualify for the USAC Elite National Track Cycling Championships in Sprint or Endurance events. Cyclists may enter to ride any or all of the events at Nationals in their qualified area.

Sprint Events

Match Sprint; Standing 250; TT (500m or 1km); Keirin, Team Sprint (M/W)

Endurance Events

Ind. Pursuit, Team Pursuit (M/W), Scratch, Points Race, and Madison

Men:

The top 5 riders in Individual events and the top 3 in the team events qualify.

Women:

The top 3 riders in individual events and the 1st team in team events qualify.

Prior to entry, cyclists should check that they meet all other requirements for entry into championship events (proof of citizenship, category restrictions, etc.). If a cyclist who is not eligible finishes in a qualifying position, that position will be assumed by the next eligible cyclist.
